## **POSITION SUMMARY:**

Perform general maintenance and landscaping duties on BIHA properties and adjacent grounds.

**AUTHORITY:** Supervised by Maintenance Supervisor

### POSITION DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Perform manual labor tasks including loading, unloading, lifting and moving materials.
- General landscaping duties including lawn mowing, weeding, and maintaining plants, flowers, trees or shrubs.
- Operating hand tools and power tools to accomplish tasks (pick shovel, weed whacker and brush cutters, pressure washer, lawn mower, etc.).
- Assists with janitorial or other maintenance duties as required.

### REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS, KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

- Some knowledge of the occupational hazards and safety precautions of lawn equipment and safety practices.
- Ability to operate and maintain all required power and hand tools in a safe manner.
- Physical strength and ability to perform a variety of routine tasks in the care and maintenance of building, grounds, and equipment under adverse weather conditions; ability to lift 50 lbs.

### **WORKING CONDITIONS:**

Baranof Island Housing Authority maintains a drug free workplace.

### OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

- Ability to pass pre-employment drug screening.
- Ability to pass pre-employment background check.
- Must be at least 21 years old.
- Must possess a valid Alaska driver's license.
